01. When do we collect data?

The TSEF collects data when you:

- Write us an email or letter
- Send us an application
- Go through the verification process with us
- Receive financial support from us
- Receive a consultation or service from us
- Subscribe to our newsletter
- Make a donation
- Visit transsafety.fund

02. What data do we collect?

The TSEF collects the following data from you, depending on the situation:

- Name
- Address
- Nationality
- Date of birth
- E-mail address
- Bank details
- Billing and payment information
- Phone Number
- Social Media
- Gender identity
- Relevant situational information

As part of the application and verification process, we may collect additional data on an individual basis if it is necessary for the process.

Only data that is truly relevant to the processes will be collected.

The TSEF stores your data only as long as necessary.

You can ask at any time by e-mail, which data about you are stored at TSEF. In doing so, you can request a change if they are demonstrably incorrect. If legally and within the framework of our processes, you can request the deletion.

03. Why do we collect data?

The TSEF collects data from you in order to fulfill its purpose. This includes, but is not limited to, emergency financial assistance for trans individuals (including the application process, verification process, and quality control) as well as fundraising events and workshops.

Various plugins are used to automatically transfer data from the website.

05. What are cookies and browser plugins?

Software, websites and offers with which we cooperate (see 04.) partly use so-called cookies. Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain viruses. Cookies serve to make their offer more user-friendly, more effective and safer. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer and saved by your browser.

Most of the cookies used are so-called session cookies. They are automatically deleted at the end of your visit. Other cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. These cookies make it possible to recognize your browser on your next visit and/or to make it easier for you to use the website. However, this data is processed anonymously.

You can set your browser so that you are informed about the setting of cookies and allow cookies only in individual cases. You can exclude the acceptance of cookies for certain cases or generally as well as activate the automatic deletion of cookies when closing the browser. If you disable cookies, the functionality of this website may be limited.

You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website. You can also prevent the collection of data generated by the cookie and related to your use of the website (including your IP address) to Google and the processing of this data by Google by downloading and installing the browser plugin available at the following link:
